# Terms and conditions

## 1. Registration, Term Duration, and Cancellation

Registration is contractually binding for a minimum of one Term (equivalent to one trimester)

Contracts automatically extend for successive Terms unless terminated in writing.

Termination Notice: To cancel your subscription, written notice must be submitted to AIM at least 1 week prior to the end of the current Term. If cancellation notice is not received on time, the customer is legally obliged to pay the full price for the successive Term. No exceptions will be made.

Early Cancellation: No refunds or credits will be issued if you choose to cancel your subscription during an active Term.

Medical Exception: In the event of a prolonged physical incapacity duly justified by a medical certificate, AIM reserves the right to review the situation on a case-by-case basis and to offer a credit or a postponement, without any obligation to refund.

Public holidays and studio closures are already considered in the pricing structure unless otherwise specified.

## 2. Payment Terms

Responsibility: It is the customer's sole responsibility to ensure that payment is cleared before the beginning of each Term. You will receive a bill via mail or what's app.

Late Fees: Following the issuance of a first payment reminder, a late payment fee of 25 € will automatically be applied to the account.

## 3. Attendance, Absences, and Supervision

Student Absence: No refunds, credits, or „make-up“ sessions will be provided for classes missed by the student. Missed classes are strictly forfeited.

Teacher Absence: In the event of a teacher's absence (e.g., due to illness), AIM reserves the right to provide a qualified substitute teacher or reschedule the session.

Supervision of Minors: AIM is only responsible for students during their scheduled class times. Parents or legal guardians are strictly responsible for the supervision and safety of children before the class begins and immediately after it concludes.

## 4. Communication

From the receipt of your registration, AIM will communicate with you via phone, email, post, and any other channels authorized by the AIM team.

The AIM team is available Monday to Friday, from 09:00 to 19:00.

Official Requests: All critical communications regarding cancellations, medical updates, or issues must be directed exclusively to AIM administration, not to the teachers. Canceling a subscription verbally or in writing to a teacher is invalid, and your contract will continue to bill automatically.

## 5. Changes, Cancellations, and Force Majeure

Policy Modifications: AIM reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions to enhance service delivery. Customers will receive advance notice of any proposed changes. The absence of a written objection will constitute acceptance of the new conditions.

Class Adjustments: AIM reserves the right to alter or cancel a class before or during a Term. In these instances, AIM will offer an alternative class or, if impossible, a prorated refund.

Force Majeure (Emergency Closures): In the event of circumstances beyond AIM's control—including but not limited to pandemics, natural disasters, extreme weather, or government-mandated closures—AIM reserves the right to transition classes to an online format or pause services. No refunds will be issued for Force Majeure events but credits will be applied in case of no classes.

## 6. Health, Liability, and Emergency Consent

Health & Fitness Declaration: By registering, the student (or legal guardian) confirms that they are in good physical health and free from any medical conditions that would restrict safe participation in physical training. It is the student's strict obligation to inform AIM and the instructor of any pre-existing injuries or physical conditions.

Participation at Own Risk: Participation in AIM classes is entirely at the student's own risk.

Limitation of Liability: To the maximum extent permitted by Luxembourg law, AIM shall not be held liable for personal injuries, accidents, illnesses, or the loss/damage of personal property occurring on the premises, provided there is no proven gross negligence or intentional misconduct on the part of the studio or its staff.

Emergency Medical Consent: In the event of a medical emergency where a student requires urgent medical care and the emergency contact or guardian cannot be reached immediately, the customer explicitly authorizes AIM staff to seek professional medical attention or summon an ambulance at the customer's expense.

## 7. Physical Contact in Pedagogy

**Explicit Consent:** By registering, the student or their legal guardian confirms that they have read and explicitly accepted that AIM teachers may make physical adjustments within an educational framework, as described in this Article 7.

**Educational Context:** AIM strives to offer individual, professional, and hands-on instruction. To correct alignment, explain techniques, or adjust body posture, it is appropriate and necessary for teachers to visually and physically guide a student.

**Methods:** Instructors may use their hands (and occasionally a foot or knee) to adjust parts of a student's body safely.

**Sensitivity & Consent:** Both teachers and students will treat physical contact with due sensitivity, professionalism, and care. A student retains the absolute right to immediately halt any physical contact that makes them feel uncomfortable in any way.

## 8. Suspension and Disciplinary Action

**Non-Compliance:** In cases of non-compliance with these Terms and Conditions, site safety rules, premises regulations, or respectful behavior toward teachers and staff, AIM reserves the right to temporarily or permanently suspend a student.

**Process:** Notice of suspension will be delivered in writing, and no refunds or credits will be issued under any circumstances.

## 9. Image Rights (GDPR Compliant)

AIM may take photographs or videos during classes, rehearsals, workshops, or events for educational, promotional, or commercial purposes.

**Authorization:** By registering, students or legal guardians authorize AIM to use such material on websites, social media platforms, advertisements, brochures, and other communication materials.

**Right to Opt-Out / Withdraw:** In compliance with GDPR, students or guardians have the right to opt out of media usage or withdraw their consent at any time. To do so, a written request must be submitted formally to AIM administration.

## 10. Data Protection (GDPR)

**Data Usage:** Your personal information is securely stored in our database to manage communications, process financial balances, provide student support, and address disciplinary actions if necessary.

**Third-Party Disclosure:** AIM will only disclose personal data to third parties when there is a valid legal basis to do so, strictly in accordance with current European and local data protection regulations.

## 11. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions are exclusively governed by Luxembourg law. Any disputes arising from or in connection with these terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Luxembourg.
